Last Sunday's market, June 9th was CRAZY busy! We had 82 Vendors in attendance which is a new record for the library parking lot. We counted approx. 1200 shoppers through the door and the line up to get in was past the library and down the road behind the Rec Center before the 8:00 horn sounded. Absolutely Amazing!

The line up for vendors was VERY long last weekend and some folks had to wait for nearly 2 hours to get checked into the market. We really appreciate everyone's patience while we get everyone parked and most vendors are very understanding. Saying that – a 2 hour wait for Vendors is way too long so we need to make a few changes to speed things up for everyone and we're asking you to work together to keep things moving and open on time.

6am Load-In:

We're going to be arriving on-site earlier so we can move up the load-in start time. We have been starting the load-in around 6:30 so far this season – this week we will be aiming for 6am!

New Drop Zone Line up:

If you don't need to keep your vehicle in the shopping area and want to skip the regular check-in line up we are introducing a new option for you – Drop Zone Line. This line will be checked in first so folks can drop off their items quickly and move their vehicles out of the way of other vendors reaching their spaces. The Drop Zone line up will be in front of the main Rec Center entrance as in the illustration below:



Back 40 and Prime Time – Additional Vendor Spaces:

Just like last year, we're opening up the Back 40 this weekend so we can fit even more Vendors into the Swap and Shop. Back-40 is the area on the grass at the end of the parking lot. The fence will be extended to enclose this area, and there is some shade back there too. This area works just like the regular Drop Zone spaces in front of the library. Let us know which area you prefer – both options are available to anyone in the Drop Zone Priority line up on a first come, first served basis.

We also have Prime Time spaces available at the front which were used for the first time last weekend. This is our Car-Boot style overflow area which we will make available to vendors as an option if we run out of space in the regular market area:



Skip All the Lines!!

If you want to skip all the vendor line ups – Vendors are encouraged to carry/cart your items in. All you need to do is walk over to see either Brendan or Sean, confirm payment, and we will assign you a Drop Zone spot right away. We have a few carts and trolleys available to anyone who wants to use them near our entrance/concession, please help yourself!

Laneways - Keep them Clear!

We found that a lot of setup time is lost because vehicles have to sit and wait for traffic to clear in the laneways. This is partly due to vendors placing items and tents too close to the lane where vehicles travel during set up. Please keep your items and tents as far back as possible so the lane ways are clear and vehicles can easily proceed past you and your items during set-up. In order to help illustrate the laneways we will be adding marker tape on the parking lot surface this week. Once we have all vehicle traffic parked we will sound a short horn blast at approx. 7:40 – this is your signal that vehicle traffic has stopped and you can spread out, moving your items and tents into the laneway if you like. Please keep EVERYTHING out of the laneway prior to the horn blast and encourage others you see setting up to do the same. This will greatly improve our ability to keep the check-in lines moving so everyone has enough time to set up. Note – this may mean that your tent cannot be set up or moved into final position until after the blast at 7:40.

Market Move July 7th!
